***DYEING YARNS WITH**
MOTHER MACKENZIE'S DYES

Cost: \$ 50 Plus \$25 materials fee

Materials fee covers approximately 1 lb. various yarns of different fibers and blends, handouts, use of dyeing equipment, and dyes used in the class.

Maximum number of students : 15

Using Mother MacKenzie's Acid Dyes, this class will focus on techniques used to produce a variety of graduated color, variegated color, rainbow dyed and spotted yarns. We will explore what happens when the base yarn is not white, how to keep white in the color mix, and ways to put color on yarns. Dyes will be in dry form and in pre-mixed liquid form for this class.

Student materials list : Old clothes or an apron, good rubber or nitril gloves, note taking and labeling materials, plastic bags to transport damp yarns from class, and any animal fiber yarns from their stash for dyeing.

Note: Student minimum would be 7
